Of the 9 Year 6 pupils, 3 were single registered. As the mainstream schools have not submitted a writing grade, we can only have the results the 6 dual registered results for writing. It is encouraging that more of our Year 6 pupils demonstrated the resilience to sit the SATS papers this year. Even though not all achieved the expected standard this is good preparation for the next steps of their education. 4 of the pupils entered were only accessing Year 4 content at the start of Year 6 and therefore made considerable progress in being able to access the SATS.
