It is encouraging that all of our Year 6 pupils demonstrated the resilience to sit the SATS papers this year. Even though not all achieved the expected standard this is good preparation for the next steps of their education. Some pupils were very close (only a few marks off) to achieving standard. Several of the dual reg pupils entered came quite late in the school year. Many of

these pupils had very low starting points and several had considerable needs so the fact that all pupils sat their SATs is a testament of the support they receive at St Thomas's Centre.

### **Year 6 2025 Analysis by category**

- 9 pupils - All pupils except one were Pupil Premium.
- 2 girls sat the Reading paper, 1 of whom (50%) achieved the expected standard.
- 2 girls sat the Maths paper, 1 of whom (50%) achieved the expected standard.
- 2 girls sat the Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling paper, 1 of whom (50%) achieved the expected standard.
- 7 boys sat the Reading paper, 0 of whom (0%) achieved the expected standard.
- 7 boys sat the Maths paper, 0 of whom (0%) achieved the expected standard.
- 7 boys sat the Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling paper, 0 of whom (0%) achieved the expected standard.
- Girls outperformed boys in all tests.
- 6 pupils who had an EHCP sat the Reading paper 1 of whom (17%) achieved the expected standard.
- 6 pupils who had an EHCP sat the Maths paper, 1 of whom (17%) achieved the expected standard.
- 6 pupils who had an EHCP sat the Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling paper, 1 of whom (17%) achieved the expected standard.
- The one CIOC pupil in the cohort sat all tests.
- Of the 9 pupils, 4 were single registered. As the mainstream schools have not submitted a writing grade, we can't analyse the 5 dual registered results for writing. Out of the 3 boys who's writing was assessed, none achieved the expected standard; one girl's writing was assessed, achieving the expected standard; 3 had an EHCP of whom 1 achieved the expected standard.
